*Please submit a copy of your State of Illinois Police Training and Standards Board certificate when returning your application packet.

Qualifications

-Applicants must have graduated with a full-time certification from a State of Illinois Police Training and Standards Board Police Academy.

-The certification must be in good standings with the State of Illinois Police Training and Standards Board.

-Applicants must be available to participate in a mandatory oral interview process with the City of Harrisburg Police and Fire Merit Board. The date will be provided by the board and upon successful completion of the process the applicant will be placed on a certified eligibility list. This list will expire on the same date as the uncertified list.

-If the Applicant is currently under contract from the transferring agency, he or she must fulfill all financial obligations of that contract. The City of Harrisburg will not assume or be liable for any financial cost incurred from the applicant's transferring agency.

-New Hires must successfully complete the probationary period in accordance with the City of Harrisburg Police Departments.

-New Hires must comply with residential guidelines established for the City of Harrisburg Police Department.
